#### **CAROL CULLEN**

It is with deep regret that we report that Club member Carol Cullen was killed in a fall on Mount Egmont shortly before 10a.m. on Saturday, 3rd July 1982.

Carol was with a party of 14 Club members staying at Tahurangi Lodge on the northern slopes of Mt. Egmont. Carol and two others left the Lodge in fine weather shortly after 8 a.m. with the intention of climbing to the summit by the normal poled route. At about. 2200 metres, near the Lizard, she apparently lost her footing and started sliding. She lost her ice axe while trying to self arrest and slid 700 metres down the slope and over bluffs. The slope was of moderate steepness where she slipped. The snow was frozen, smooth and ideal for cramponing.

Carol was well known for her physical fitness, infectious enthusiasm and cheerfulness. Carol was a Committee member and the newsletter editor. The Club extends its sincerest condolences to Carol's family and friends.
